- Job adverts for professional, managerial and support roles aren't live for as long as academic roles, largely due to the high application rate and the quality of talent jobs.ac.uk attracts
- Compared to academic opportunities, professional and managerial opportunities are more likely to be permanent (61%) and full time (86%)



Overview of all roles advertised on jobs.ac.uk in the UK and Republic of Ireland




- On average recruitment adverts on jobs.ac.uk for professional, managerial and support roles were posted for 20 days, attracting 319 views and 13 apply clicks










