- Our data is purely based on the 50,155 jobs posted by higher education institutions in the UK and Republic of Ireland on jobs.ac.uk from 1 August 2020 to 31 July 2020
- Our top-level statistics state the actual number of job adverts
- When we focus on the segmented job categories, we refer to job opportunities rather than adverts, as some adverts span several disciplines or feature different job roles. Therefore a specific advert may feature in different areas of this report and the number of job opportunities is higher than the number of adverts
- In our report we rounded numbers to the nearest whole number except where numbers were less than 0.5
- Where data has been segmented into different job roles we didn't include categories with less than five opportunities as there wasn't enough data to inform trends
- When we refer to 'Average Apply Clicks', we refer only to clicks made directly to the 'Apply' button

Executive summary

TRENDS

- Jobs adverts for professional, managerial and support roles aren't live for as long as academic roles, largely due to the high application rate and the quality of talent jobs.ac.uk attracts
- Compared to academic opportunities, professional and managerial opportunities are more likely to be permanent (61%) and full-time (86%)
- The summer months are the most popular time to advertise support roles

- 17,950 professional, managerial and support adverts were posted on jobs.ac.uk by higher education institutions in the UK and Ireland between 1 August 2020 to 31 July 2020
- Professional, managerial and support opportunities account for 30% of all opportunities advertised on jobs.ac.uk
- After academic opportunities, professional, managerial and support roles are the second most advertised opportunities on jobs.ac.uk
- 44% of professional, managerial and support roles were advertised in London and South East England
- 62% of professional and managerial roles offered salaries between £25,000 - £49,999



Overview of all roles advertised on jobs.ac.uk in the UK and Republic of Ireland




- On average recruitment adverts on jobs.ac.uk for professional, managerial and support roles were posted for 15 days, attracting 431 views and 21 apply clicks








